2023-2024 School Year

Welcome to the Stanwood Cooperative Preschool! We are an early childhood preschool program that provides an educational opportunity for both the child and adult. Enclosed is some general information about our preschool, however if you have additional questions, please feel free to contact the school or visit our website.

The **2023-2024** school year will have the following classes :

<u>Toddler Time</u> (18mo.-3 yr olds: must be 18mo by 8/31/23)	Tuesday/Thursday	9:10 am-11:10 am
<u>AM 3-5 yr old Class</u> (3-5 yr olds: must be 3 by 8/31/23)	Wednesday/Friday	9:10 am-11:40 am
<u>PM 3-5 yr olds Class</u> (3-5 yr old: must be 3 by 8/31/23)	Wed/Thurs/Fri	12:00 pm-2:30 pm
<u>Discovery Program</u> (3-5 yr olds: must be 3 by 8/31/23)	Tuesday	12:00 pm-2:30 pm

SCP allows children to enroll in multiple classes providing they are age appropriate. Limited scholarships are available for all classes. Please speak to our Director for scholarship details, guidelines and availability. SCP reserves the right to change tuition rates prior to classes beginning in the fall. SCP also reserves the right to cancel classes at any point in the school year due to low enrollment.

The preschool is a cooperative program where the adults work together with the teacher to provide a quality, rewarding preschool experience. As part of participation, cooperative parents have the following requirements.

- work one day per week in the classroom for each child enrolled
- attend parent meetings as scheduled (approx. 3x's per school year)
- participate in parent education sessions (attend at least 4 of the 6 scheduled)
- contribute to the preschool with committee work
- pay fees required for enrollment and monthly tuition
- provide snacks on a rotating basis for your class
- participate in the routine clean-up of the preschool on a rotating basis
- actively participate in annual fund raising events

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Class Descriptions

Toddler Class Tuesday & Thursday 9:10 am- 11:10 am

From 18 months to 3 years of age, children are curious about the world around them. This class is designed for children to use their gross motor skills to explore the classroom. Parents, or care-givers, attend during this hour and a half class participating in small group discussions and parent education, as well as exploring the classroom with their child. Activities are specially designed with the toddler exploration in mind. Minimum 10 kids per class. Maximum 14 kids per class. Cost is \$60/month.

Children must be 18 months by August 31, 2023 **Children do not need to be potty independent**

AM 3-5 Year Old Class Wednesday & Friday 9:10 am- 11:40 am

The 3-5 preschool class offers age appropriate early learning opportunities and promotes social and emotional development. Our curriculum helps foster creativity and independence using play stations, such as: library, dramatic play, art area, sensory zone, and large & small motor activities. Our classroom is a place where children will grow in a safe and fun environment.

Minimum 12 kids per class. Maximum 18 kids per class. Cost is \$115/month. **Children must be 3 by August 31, 2023**

****Children do not need to be potty independent****

PM 3-5 Year Old Class : Wednesday, Thursday, Friday 12:00 pm- 2:30 pm

In this classroom setting, the children will continue their active exploration of their environment. Large and small group activities throughout the day give children the opportunity to engage in activities fostering literacy, math development, self-esteem and social awareness. The three day a week rotation allows for a more in depth coverage of the curriculum. The class allows parents to grow and learn beside their child and gain valuable parenting education and skills. Minimum 12 kids per class. Maximum 18 kids per class. Cost is \$195/month. **Children must be 4 by August 31, 2023 **Children do not need to be potty independent****

Discovery Program: Tuesday 12:00 pm- 2:30 pm

We are elated to provide this class again this school year! This is an extension of our regular preschool classes with an in-depth, multi-week study of topics including: Science, Cooking, Animals, Theater, Music and Cultural Studies. This is a great opportunity to introduce preschoolers to a variety of topics designed to engage and excite young minds. Families participating in homeschool or drop off preschool elsewhere often enjoy joining the co-op for this fun and engaging addition to their preschooler's academic endeavors. Co-op parents who want 3 or 4 day a week preschool options often add this class to their weekly routine as well. Minimum 10 kids per class. Maximum 15 kids per class. Cost is \$65/month. **Children must be 3 by August 31, 2023 **Children do not need to be potty independent****
